RULES AND REGULATIONS

Four Classes: Pure Street, Street Tire, and 2 classes of Slicks (Over 10.5 inches wide, and Under 10.5 inches wide). DOT Street Tires have to have a significant tread pattern to qualify for Street Class. Class will be determined by the racing director.

Pure Street Rules: Must be your Daily Driver, must be driven to event, full interior, no powers adders (unless factory equipment). This class is intended for the people with regular vehicles to enjoy racing. NO STREET LEGAL RACING TIRES. Anybody with street racing tires will be run with small tire slick class. Please don't take advantage of this class. (Racing Director will have final say in what class you will run in).

Slick Tire Rules: Two classes, over 10.5 inches wide and under 10.5 inches wide. Must be naturally aspirated. No power adders added at any time. Any slick tire shown up with power adders will run with big tire class.

Street Tire Rules: Street legal racing tires can be with boost.

- 1. Number of Runs:** Every driver receives two (2) runs. If you lose, you must have your window marked by an official on the return road. If you lose both runs you are finished, unless you want to grudge race anyone.
- 2. Run Schedule:** When your number is called, you MUST get your window marked and make a run.
- 3. Staging Lanes:** Line up side by side were directed by the designated official. The racing director will draw numbers that determine who race and in which lane.
- 4. Burnouts:** When you are called to race you may pull into the water box and do a SHORT burnout. It is recommended that vehicles with street tires drive around the water.
- 5. RACING: Safety** is the utmost importance! No hot-dogging in car show area or return lanes. **All traffic laws will be observed!** During drag racing, **if a car gets loose – Get out of the throttle. Do not try and drive through it!** If you stay in it and drive through what is deemed to be a potentially dangerous situation, you will be disqualified and asked to leave the event.
- 6. Shutdown:** You must be slowed to 5 miles per hour by the intersection of Main & 3rd. You will then turn right and follow the return road. **YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FOR EXCESSIVE SPEED AT THE END OF THE SHUTDOWN AREA OR IN THE RETURN ROAD.**

7. **Grudge Racing:** You may apply for a grudge race after you have been eliminated. Grudge races will run either before the final or during cool down times.
8. **Safety: BE SAFE!** This is a family event. Watch out for spectators and children on bicycles! Unsafe behavior will lead to disqualification. **NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON PUBLIC PROPERTY; VIOLATORS WILL BE TICKETED.**
